

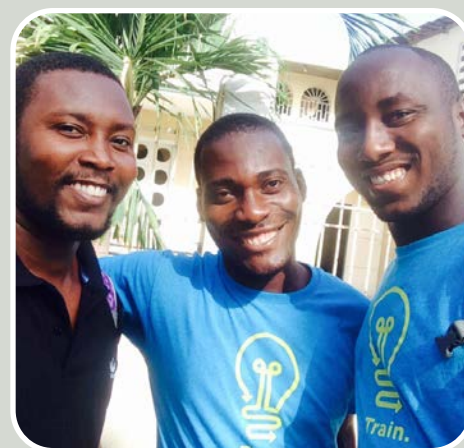

Alix led his clubs with clowning, a creative way to share the gospel with fun and laughter. He also directed a kids club choir that will lead worship on June 7th. Five students came to Christ this month under Alix's leadership.

Jusme, who organizes the largest kids club every Saturday, also had a busy month. He preached at his home church, taught Bible studies to adults and youth, coached his soccer team, and conducted his kids clubs in Bonnette and Meyer.

Over 550 children participated in kids clubs this month. What an outreach!
